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Zanzibar Two Day Guided Motorcycle Tour



Meeting Time: 08.30
Trip starts: 09.00 hrs.
Trip ends: 17.00 hrs.
Duration: 2 days, 1 night

Day 1: Embark on a unique two day guided tour of Zanzibar in the saddle of a Royal Enfield motorcycle. Start the day from our Royal Enfield centre located on the outskirts of the historic Stone Town and just a few minutes transfer from the International Airport. Meet and greet with our team followed by a short trip briefing hosted by your guide and during which you will be introduced to your ride for the trip.

Depart our centre following the briefing and head eastward out of the town area with Uzi Island as the trip's first highlight. Ride on a busy tarred road as you leave the urban centre

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around Stone Town and find other traffic dwindle within the first 20 or so kilometres of riding. Out of the main urban area enjoy the road lined by beautiful lush green tropical coastal forests consisting of a myriad of tropical fruit and other hardwood trees, such as Mango, Banana, Papaya, Lichee, Bungo, Lime, Cloves, the majestic East African Tall Coconut and much more. Stop at a fruit stall to see what is on offer and savour some delicious fruit. Head southward and ride along a unique coral road carved through a tidal Mangrove forest connecting the main island of Zanzibar (*Unguja*) with the satellite island of Uzi. Ride across the island and gain an insight into Swahili cultural village life. Enjoy a Swahili seafood lunch and then head back across the coral road before the tide rises enough to prevent the crossing back to the main island. Proceed to ride southward through beautiful lush vegetation so as to arrive on the southern point of the island by late afternoon. Settle into your hotel for the night and enjoy a beautiful sunset scenario, swim in the warm waters of the Indian Ocean and overnight at [Unguja Lodge](#) on the southern tip of Zanzibar.



Day 2: For those up to it, wake up at dawn and ride a short way to the beach fish landing site of Kizimkazi Village. Other than during full moons, a fleet of traditionally built fishing Dhow's set off every evening to lay their drift nets in the open ocean waters that surround the southern tip of the island. The fleet lands its impressive catch at the landing site early every morning, which brings a good part of the entire village to the beach to witness what is brought in. The activities surrounding the auctioning, buying and selling, portioning and transporting of the catch are a sight to see. This traditional fishing community is responsible for the seafood you eat at nearby restaurants. Head back to the hotel by 08.00 in time for a hearty breakfast and be ready to ride by 10.00 hrs.



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Head out from the hotel and ride to Mtende Village to meet an ancient magical tree, a massive Baobab tree likely to be between 1,000 - 1,500 years of age. After a short visit to this magical tree, ride on through the village to the coastal cliffs overlooking the Indian Ocean. This is a spectacular part of the island and not as frequented as the busy beaches of the east coast. Soak in the view of this beautiful location from a small cozy restaurant on the cliffs while sipping a refreshing juice, or feel free to wander down to the beach and walk around. After a short stop, get back on the saddle of your motorcycle and ride out through the village and head a little further east and up along the east coast of the island, past the popular beach of Jambiani Beach. Stop by Zanzibar's kite surfing 'Mecca,' Paje Beach and have a coffee at a popular beach cafe overlooking the stunning beach. Soak in the view with all of its blend of turquoise, blue, green and whites and enjoy lunch at this location. After lunch, head on northward past Bwejuu and to Michamvi Beach. Stop by the beach to see the location of the world famous 'The Rock' restaurant, and should you want to, for a coffee at a spectacular beach restaurant with a view of the white beach and beautiful tidal lagoon in front of it. Tide permitting, swim in the ocean before heading off on your return trip to where the ride started from, so as to arrive by 17.00 hrs. Trip ends.
