Zanzibar Three Day Guided Motorcycle Tour




Meeting Time:	08.30 on day

Duration:	3 days, 2 nights

Day 1: Embark on a unique three day guided tour of Zanzibar in the saddle of a Royal Enfield motorcycle. Start the day from our Royal Enfield centre located on the outskirts of the historic Stone Town and just a few minutes transfer from the International Airport. Meet and greet with our team followed by a short trip briefing hosted by your guide and during which you will be introduced to your ride for the trip.

Depart our centre following the briefing and head south to Uzi Island (tide allowing). Ride on a busy tarred road as you leave the urban centre around Stone Town and find other traffic dwindle within the first 20 or so kilometres of riding. Out of the main urban area

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enjoy the road lined by beautiful lush green tropical coastal forest consisting of a myriad of tropical fruit and other hardwood trees, such as Mango, Banana, Papaya, Lichee, Bungo, Lime, Cloves, the majestic East African Tall Coconut and much more. Stop at a fruit stall to see what is on offer and savour some delicious fruit.





a mangrove forest and linking Uzi Island with the main island of Zanzibar (Unguja). Ride across the island and gain an insight into Swahili cultural village life. Enjoy a Swahili seafood lunch and then head back across the coral road before the tide rises enough to prevent the crossing back to the main island. Head southward so as to reach the southern point of the island by mid afternoon and check into your hotel for the night. Enjoy a swim in the warm and clear waters in front of your hotel (tide dependent) and relax to enjoy sundowners while you watch the sunset over the ocean. Dinner and overnight at <u>Unguja Lodge</u> on the southern tip of the island.

Day 2: For those happy to wake up early, rise at 06.15 hrs and head on a short ride to nearby Kizimkazi Village beach to witness the landing of fresh fish by the village's night fleet. Witness a myriad of fish species, from Yellowfin Tuna, Sailfish, and Marlin to Shark, Kingfish and Dorado, being auctioned right in front of you on the beach. It can be quite a spectacle. Breakfast by 09.00 hrs and ready to ride by 10.00 hrs to



another nearby village, Mtende. Stop by a majestic 1,000 year old Baobab tree and continue onwards to the cliff faces of the ocean front a little off the village boundary. Witness how women make traditional ropes out of coconut fibre by first burying them into the sand in the sea for a few months at a time. The scenery here is spectacular and few tourists venture to this place.

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Then get back in the saddle and ride north-eastward through Makunduchi village and on to Paje Beach. Stop at a popular place on the beach to enjoy a coffee or cold drink while

taking in this spectacular beach made very popular by its kite surfing scene. Lunch by the beach in Paje and then set off for a short ride northward to Pingwe where your accommodation for the night is located. Our choice for this location is a stunning villa located within a few metres of the white powdery beach lapped by the turquoise warm and clear waters of the lagoon. Check into your accommodation and settle in, take



some time to cool down during the hot hours of the day and choose to take a ride to Michamvi Kae to visit a popular beach bar famous for its sunsets. Then ride back to your hotel for the night. Or skip the short ride to the beach bar and rather have sundowners at the villa and head to the wonderful nearby restaurant, a short walk along the beach, for a



wonderful western fusion style dinner and thirst quenching cocktails and craft beers. Overnight at <u>Villa Hekaya</u> private villa on Michamvi Beach.

Day 3: Morning at leisure so as to enjoy the beauty of this location. Swim, relax, breakfast, enjoy the place. Then set off from the hotel and head to a beautiful spice farm located just north-east of Stone Town. Participate in an interesting spice tour on the farm to witness how the spices the island is

famous for are grown and marketed for various uses. This is followed by a delicious lunch prepared on the farm using spices and other ingredients from the farm. After lunch ride to the Stone Town and stop by the waterfront area of Forodhani famous for its night street food market. From there ride through the Stone Town to our base to end the tour.
