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Zanzibar Four Day Guided Motorcycle Tour



Meeting Time:	08.30

Duration:	3 nights, 4 days

Day 1: Embark on a unique four day guided tour of Zanzibar in the saddle of a Royal Enfield motorcycle. Start the day from our Royal Enfield centre located on the outskirts of the historic Stone Town and just a few minutes transfer from the International Airport. Meet and greet with our team followed by a short trip briefing hosted by your guide and during which you will be introduced to your ride for the trip.

Depart our centre following the briefing and head northward to a spice farm some 20 or so kilometres out of the busy urban centre around Stone Town. Ride on a busy tarred road as you leave the urban centre around Stone Town and find other traffic dwindle within the first 10 or so kilometres of riding. Out of the main urban area enjoy the road

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lined by beautiful lush green tropical coastal forest consisting of a myriad of tropical fruit and other hardwood trees, such as Mango, Banana, Papaya, Lichee, Bungo, Lime,

Cloves, the majestic East African Tall Coconut and much more. Stop at a fruit stall to see what is on offer and savour some delicious fruit.

Once at the spice farm, enjoy a guided tour of the farm whereby many of the spices Zanzibar is historically famous for are grown. Learn what they are used for and enjoy a delicious and savoury Swahili meal prepared using the spices grown on the farm. Lunch at the farm. After



lunch, ride northward End the northern point in time to check into your carefully chosen and comfortable hotel for the night. Enjoy a relaxing calming swim into the warm clear waters prior to enjoying sundowners and a delicious dinner on the wood deck restaurant overlooking the stunning sea. Overnight at <u>Langi Langi Beach Resort</u> on the northern point of the island.

Day 2: For those up to it, wake up at dawn and walk through the village on a cultural tour that takes you to one of the largest fish landing sites on Unguja Island. Other

than during full moons, a fleet of well over 100 traditionally built fishing Dhow's set off every evening to lay their drift nets in the open ocean waters that surround the northern tip of the island. The fleet lands its impressive catch at the landing site early every morning, which brings a good part of the entire village to the beach to witness what is brought in. The activities surrounding the auctioning, buying



and selling, portioning and transporting of the catch are a sight to see. Walk through the mostly stone built houses to have an insight into Zanzibari culture surrounding a traditional fishing community.

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Head back to the hotel by 08.00 to join the rest of the group and in time for a hearty breakfast and be ready to ride by 10.00 hrs. Ride southward and along the north-eastern

coast of the island. Occasionally stop to have a refreshing drink or at photo opportunities and stop for lunch at a stunning location overlooking the beautiful lagoon that characterises the coastline along the island's east coast. After lunch continue your ride southward so as to arrive in Michamvi, on the south-east coast of the island, in time for checking in to your comfortable hotel for the



night and swim in the stunningly beautiful lagoon that characterises that area of Zanzibar. Our choice for this location is a stunning villa located within a few metres of the white powdery beach lapped by the turquoise warm and clear waters of the lagoon. Have sundowners at the villa and head to the wonderful nearby restaurant, a short walk along the beach, for a wonderful western fusion style dinner and thirst quenching cocktails and craft beers. Overnight at <u>Villa Hekaya</u> private villa on Michamvi Beach.

Day 3: Morning at leisure so as to enjoy the beauty of this location. Breakfast, swim, relax, enjoy the place and after breakfast head to Jozani Forest for a walk to see the endemic Red Colobus monkeys of Zanzibar. Lunch at a local restaurant nearby and

then head southward through some lush vegetation along a beautiful tar road. Arrive at your hotel on the southern point of the island in time to enjoy sundowners with the sun setting over the ocean. Dinner and overnight at <u>Unguja Lodge</u> on the southern tip of the island.

Day 4: Breakfast by 08.30 and depart the hotel by 09.30 hrs and ride to Mtende



Village to meet an ancient magical tree, a massive Baobab tree likely to be between 1,000 - 1,500 years of age. After a short visit to this magical tree, ride on through the village to the coastal cliffs overlooking the Indian Ocean. This is a spectacular part of the island

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and not as frequented as the busy beaches of the east coast. Soak in the view of this beautiful location from a small cozy restaurant on the cliffs while sipping a refreshing juice, or feel free to wander down to the beach and walk around. After a short stop, get back on the saddle of your motorcycle and ride out through the village and head a little further east and up along the east coast of the island, past the popular beach of Jambiani Beach.

Then head westward back towards Stone Town and detour to ride along a unique coral road carved through a tidal Mangrove forest connecting the main island of Zanzibar (*Unguja*) with the satellite island of Uzi. Ride across the island and gain an insight into Swahili cultural village life. Enjoy a Swahili seafood lunch and then head back across the coral road before the tide rises enough to prevent the crossing back to the main island. Ride back to Stone Town area so as to arrive at our centre to complete the trip. End of trip.
